Student Enrollment Agreement

This Student Enrollment Agreement (“Agreement”) is entered into between **NMP Somatic Education Canada**, operating as **NMP Somatics™** (“Provider”), and the undersigned participant (“Student”).

By enrolling in any NMP Somatics™ training program, the Student agrees to the following terms.

1. Enrollment and Participation

Enrollment in NMP Somatics™ training grants the Student access to educational instruction, training materials, and related resources for the duration of the program or access period provided.

Enrollment does not guarantee certification, teaching authorization, or professional designation.

Certification and teaching permissions are granted only according to the applicable program requirements, agreements, assessments, and formal approval processes.

2. Program Structure

NMP Somatics™ training is progressive and modular.

Each module builds on the previous level of training and may include live instruction, recorded instruction, practice assignments, written materials, movement exploration, teaching practice, and other educational components.

Completion of modules may permit teaching of specific NMP Somatics™ class formats under the **Teacher in Training** designation, as outlined in the separate **Teaching, Licensing & Branding Agreement**.

Level 1 certification as a:

Certified Somatic Exercise Teacher – NMP Method (Level 1)
CSET–NMP Level 1

is awarded only upon:

- Completion of required modules
- Successful completion of the Final Project and/or required assessments
- Formal approval by NMP Somatic Education Canada
- Completion of any required agreements or documentation

3. Tuition and Payment Terms

Full tuition or approved payment arrangements must be completed prior to or in accordance with enrollment terms.

Failure to complete payment may result in:

- Suspension of access to training materials or program resources
- Removal from the training program
- Withholding of assessment, certification, or teaching authorization

All fees are listed in Canadian dollars unless otherwise stated.

4. Refunds, Cancellations, and Transfers

Refunds, cancellations, withdrawals, transfers, deposits, missed sessions, accessed materials, and Final Project fees are governed by the current **NMP Somatics™ Refund & Cancellation Policy**.

By enrolling, the Student acknowledges that they have reviewed and agreed to the Refund & Cancellation Policy.

5. Attendance and Completion Requirements

Students are responsible for:

- Attending scheduled sessions live or by recording, where applicable
- Completing required homework, practice hours, assignments, or submissions
- Participating respectfully in group learning environments
- Communicating in advance when they are unable to attend or meet a deadline

Failure to meet attendance, participation, or completion requirements may delay eligibility for assessment, teaching authorization, or certification.

6. Intellectual Property and Use of Materials

All course materials, outlines, manuals, scripts, presentations, recordings, assessments, class structures, and proprietary formats remain the exclusive property of NMP Somatic Education Canada.

Access to materials does not constitute ownership.

Students may not copy, distribute, resell, reproduce, upload, publicly share, or teach from proprietary materials except as expressly permitted by NMP Somatic Education Canada.

Students may not share login credentials or provide unauthorized access to training materials.

7. Recording and Media

Live training sessions may be recorded for educational purposes.

By participating in live training sessions, the Student consents to being included in recordings used for internal educational purposes, student review, or program access.

Separate written consent will be obtained for any public promotional use of identifiable images, video, or testimonials.

8. Professional Conduct

Students agree to maintain professional, respectful, and ethical conduct throughout training.

Students are expected to follow the current **NMP Somatics™ Code of Professional Conduct** and any applicable program expectations.

Disruptive, abusive, unethical, or unsafe behaviour may result in removal from training, suspension of access, or loss of program privileges.

9. Scope of Training

NMP Somatics™ training is educational in nature.

The program does not provide:

- Medical licensure
- Healthcare certification
- Authority to diagnose or treat medical conditions
- Authorization to work beyond the Student's professional scope, licensing, or local regulations

Students are responsible for practicing within their own professional qualifications, scope of practice, and jurisdictional requirements.

10. Assumption of Risk

Participation in somatic movement training involves voluntary physical activity.

The Student acknowledges that:

- They are responsible for monitoring their own physical condition
- They will move within comfort and personal limits
- They may choose not to participate in any movement or activity
- They assume responsibility for their own participation

If the Student has medical concerns, injuries, or conditions that may affect participation, they agree to consult a licensed healthcare provider before participating.

11. Limitation of Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by law, NMP Somatic Education Canada shall not be liable for injury, loss, business outcomes, indirect damages, or consequential damages arising from participation in training, use of materials, or later application of the work.

Participation is voluntary and undertaken at the Student's own discretion.

12. Additional Agreements and Policies

The Student understands that participation in NMP Somatics™ training may also be subject to additional agreements, policies, or guidelines, including but not limited to:

- Refund & Cancellation Policy

- Code of Professional Conduct
- Teaching, Licensing & Branding Agreement
- Approved Naming & Language Guidelines
- Final Project & Certification Agreement, where applicable

These documents may govern specific areas of participation, teaching authorization, certification, conduct, branding, refunds, and public representation.

13. Amendments

NMP Somatic Education Canada reserves the right to update program policies, agreements, requirements, and guidelines as the training evolves.

Continued participation in training or continued access to program materials constitutes acceptance of updated terms.

14. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Province of Alberta, Canada.
